GENERAL FUNCTION:

Responsible for supervising after school participants and implementing the program designed for school age youth (Young 5's-4th Grade). Work directly with supervisor to develop programs that are in accordance with the YMCA core principles, Healthy Eating and Physical Activity standards, and Global Learning objectives. Supervise Assistant Teachers. Responsible for planning all school days off, vacation breaks and snow days including processing registrations.

REQUIREMENTS:

- **1 years' experience in an school age childhood setting working with children ages 5-14 is required.**
