Financial Assistance for Camp AGQ | 2021

Camp AGQ (Ann Arbor YMCA) offers financial assistance for families on a case-by-case basis dependent upon gross annual income, household size, and special circumstances. The goal of the AGQ Scholarship Program is to provide a unique overnight summer camp experience that is available to all regardless of financial status.

How do I apply?

Scholarships are requested during the registration process, which can be done online or by phone.

We recommend signing your camper up for their session of choice as soon as registration opens so that their spot is reserved while your scholarship application is reviewed.

What can I apply for?

Scholarships can be requested for core sessions and add-on activities. We cover up to two weeks of core sessions and up to two weeks of add-ons (i.e., Waterskiing). Bus transportation scholarships are determined based upon the scholarship percentage that you receive.

During Online Registration

On the first page that asks for your camper's information, make sure to select the appropriate option for whether or not you are a scholarship applicant.

Income Documentation

Income documentation is **required** for all scholarship requests and must be submitted by **February 1, 2021**. Documentation can be submitted during or after registration through any of the following methods:

For **families with two adults** in a household, we require income documentation from all adults who work and/or attend school. If one adult does not work and/or attend school, please specify this when submitting your request so that we can properly review your case.

For **single parent families**, we require documentation from the sole adult responsible for the household. If there is an elder, or adult child living in the household, please clarify whether or not they contribute to the household income.

All of the following forms of income documentation that apply to your family are required. If we do not receive income documentation that clearly outlines your household income, we will reach out to you asking for further paperwork.

COVID-19

Due to the global COVID-19 pandemic, we understand that Federal Taxes from 2019 may not represent your family's current income. Please attach supplementary documentation such as paystubs, unemployment documentation, or a letter from your former/current employer that explains your situation so that we can base your scholarship off of your current income.

Reduced Deposit

A \$15 deposit per session is required to complete registration and reserve a camper's spot.

Important Dates

- All income documentation for scholarship applicants is due by **February 1, 2021**
- Awards, instructions for acceptance, and payment options will be provided on **February 5, 2021**
- Offers must be accepted before **February 10, 2021**
- First installment of payment plan will be charged on **February 15, 2021**

**Requests submitted between January 28th – February 15th will be reviewed in March on a first-come-first serve basis.*
