### REGISTRATION

Registration opens Sunday, September 29th at 11:00 A.M.

### HOW TO REGISTER ONLINE

If you have registered for camps in the past, please use the email address associated with your CampInTouch account to begin your camp registration for Out of School Time 2024–2025.

If you do not have an account, follow the steps below:

**Step 1:** Go to the Ann Arbor YMCA web page and click the dark green 'Camp Registration' button located at the top of the web page or click <u>HERE</u>.

NOTE: Do not select the red 'Register' button at the top of the page.

**Step 2:** Enter your first name, last name, email address, and your relationship to the camper(s).

Step 3: Create a password for your account.

Step 4: Enter your camper's information (e.g., name, date of birth, address, etc.)

### **DEPOSITS AND PAYMENT PLANS**

Deposits are \$10 for members and non-members, and \$5 for scholarship applicants regardless of membership status. Deposits are paid per camp day. <u>Post-Care deposit fees for members and non-members are \$5. No Post-Care deposit required for scholarship applicants.</u>

# **GENERAL INFORMATION (CONT.)**

#### All Camps – Monthly Payment Plan

By selecting this option, you agree to have the Ann Arbor YMCA charge your credit card in equal installments on the following dates: November 1<sup>st</sup>, December 2<sup>nd</sup>, January 2<sup>nd</sup>, February 3<sup>rd</sup>, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, April 1<sup>st</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup>. You will receive a statement one week prior to your card being charged.

#### **REFUND AND TRANSFER POLICY**

Deposits are non-refundable under any circumstances. At the time of registration, a deposit is due for each session for which the camper is registering.

<u>Up to three weeks before</u> the beginning of the specific camp day, all funds, excluding the deposit, are refundable and transferable within other day camp programs as space allows. This includes camp balance dues. <u>Within three weeks</u> of the beginning of the specific camp day, all funds are non-refundable and non-transferable to a balance due or to a new registration. If a camper, without notice, does not attend a day for which they are registered, there will be no refund issued. In cases of homesickness, dismissal or voluntary withdrawal, there will be no refund of any fees.

### **DAY CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS**

At the Y, we believe that every person who would like to should have the opportunity to participate in our programs. 


# **CAMP NEW HEIGHTS Q** YPSILANTI, MI






