REGISTRATION

Registration opens Saturday, September 6th at 11:00 A.M.

HOW TO REGISTER ONLINE

If you have registered for camps in the past, please use the email address associated with your CampInTouch account to begin your camp registration for Out of School Time 2025–2026.

If you do not have an account, follow the steps below:

Step 1: Go to the Ann Arbor YMCA web page and click the dark green 'Camp Registration' button located at the top of the web page or click <u>HERE</u>.

NOTE: Do not select the red 'Register' button at the top of the page.

Step 2: Enter your first name, last name, email address, and your relationship to the camper(s).

Step 3: Create a password for your account.

Step 4: Enter your camper's information (e.g., name, date of birth, address, etc.)

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENT PLANS

Deposits are \$10 for members and non-members, and \$5 for scholarship applicants regardless of membership status. Deposits are paid per camp day. Post-Care deposit fees for members and non-members are \$5. No Post-Care deposit required for scholarship applicants.

LATE REGISTRATION FEE

Those registering within seven or fewer days before the selected OST Camp Date will be charged an additional fee of \$15 per camper(s), regardless of membership status.

GENERAL INFORMATION (CONT.)

Out of School Time Camps – Payment Plan

By selecting this option, you agree to have the Ann Arbor YMCA charge your credit card in equal installments on the following dates: November 3rd, December 1st, January 2nd, February 2nd, March 2nd, April 1st and May 1st. You will receive a statement one week prior to your card being charged.

*Please note that if you register for summer 2026, your payment plan will change to the All Camps payment plan that goes through August 2026. Payments will come out on the 15th.

REFUND AND TRANSFER POLICY

Deposits are non-refundable under any circumstances. At the time of registration, a deposit is due for each session for which the camper is registering.

<u>Up to three weeks before</u> the beginning of the specific camp day, all funds, excluding the deposit, are refundable and transferable within other day camp programs as space allows. This includes camp balance dues. <u>Within three weeks</u> of the beginning of the specific camp day, all funds are non-refundable and non-transferable to a balance due or to a new registration. If a camper, without notice, does not attend a day for which they are registered, there will be no refund issued. In cases of homesickness, dismissal or voluntary withdrawal, there will be no refund of any fees.

LOW ENROLLMENT & SNOW DAYS

In the event a camp session has too low of enrollment to adequately provide an enriching day camp experience, the session may be cancelled. Camp families will receive notice prior to the cancelled session and spaces will be offered in another camp as space allows to those whose original bookings have been cancelled. Camp families will be refunded the full balance of the cancelled session if their session is not able to be rebooked to another camp during the original session.

Out of School Time Camp is not held on unexpected weather days such as snow days.
